

**TOWN OF CAMDEN
RECYCLING PROGRAM
EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2002**

The Town of Camden has been awarded two grants to expand its current curbside recycling effort from the Department of Natural Resources, Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Branch. The two grants are going to supply the residents with additional recycling boxes and new newspaper boxes as well as a recycling trailer to assist our maintenance department in collecting the items efficiently. Effective July 1, 2002, the Town of Camden will revise its recycling program to include not only newspapers but also narrow necked plastic bottles. *(See chart below for acceptable items.) In an effort to expand the program to include all of the residents, the Town will be establishing a weekly pickup to include certain streets every other week.

MATERIAL	YES	NO
PAPER Newspapers, Magazines, Phone books	Keep paper dry and clean. They should be put in container loose. (Newspaper inserts can stay in.)	NO – junk mail, copy paper, envelopes, boxboard, cereal boxes, or plastic bags.
PLASTIC Narrow-neck Bottles <u>ONLY</u>	Empty and rinse. Labels can stay on. Discard lid. Please compact. Milk jugs, soda bottles, laundry detergent bottles, shampoo bottles.	NO – plastic bags, butter tubs, yogurt containers, Styrofoam, motor oil containers.
CANS Aluminum, Steel, Empty aerosol	Empty and rinse. Labels can stay on. Food and beverage cans, pet food, empty spray cans.	NO – pie pans, paint cans, lawn chairs, foil, scrap aluminum, screen doors, siding.

The **blue** boxes will now be used for plastic and cans. Our maintenance department will be delivering the boxes as requests are received.
